## **Private Boat Racking Protocol**

Limited private equipment such as single sculls and oars can be racked by current financial members at the club.

## <u>Terms</u>

- 1. The Club recognises that rowing equipment is expensive and treats all boats with the utmost care.
- 2. Private boats can be stored for a fee at the Club's discretion on receipt and approval by the Club Committee of a Private Boat Rack Request.
- 3. Rack allocation is delegated to Club Captain.
- 4. Storage of club equipment will always be prioritised.
- 5. When allocating rack space, common sense and fairness will be applied and decisions that are made will be consistent with the values and objectives of the club.
- 6. The private boat owner accepts that their boat is stored at the club at their own risk.
- 7. The club takes no responsibility for any unauthorised use of a private boat.
- 8. An annual fee will be set by the committee at the start of each rowing season and invoiced accordingly.
- 9. Refunds will not be given if the boat is moved out of the shed during the year.
- 10. Removal of a private boat requires the written permission of the boat owner plus a notification to the Club Captain.
